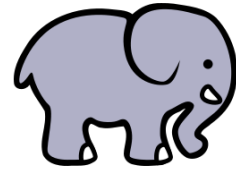


# Elephants

Wolves normally live in mountains, forests and deserts. ~~But~~ <sup>arctic</sup> ~~arctic~~ fox lives in cold places.

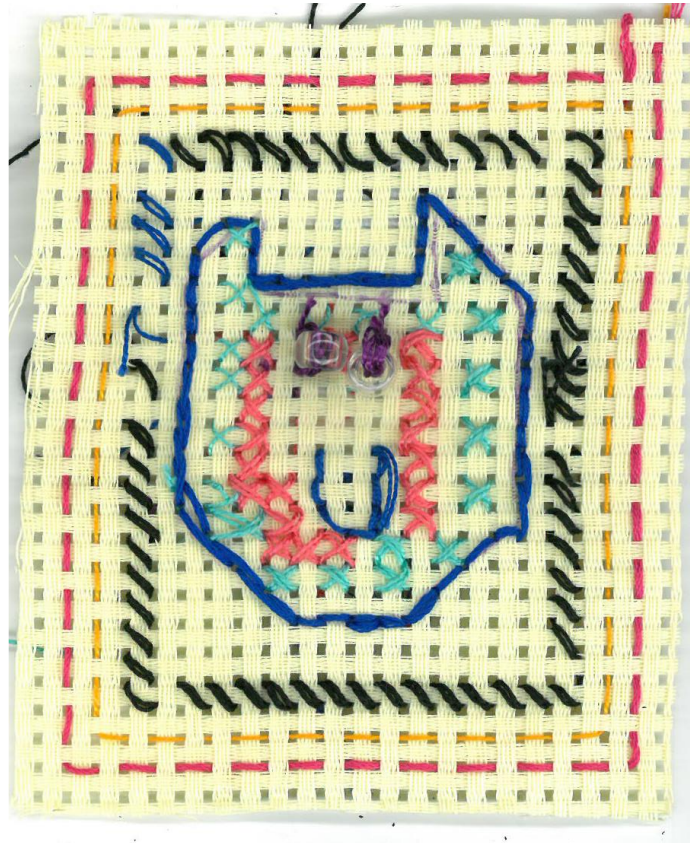
eating

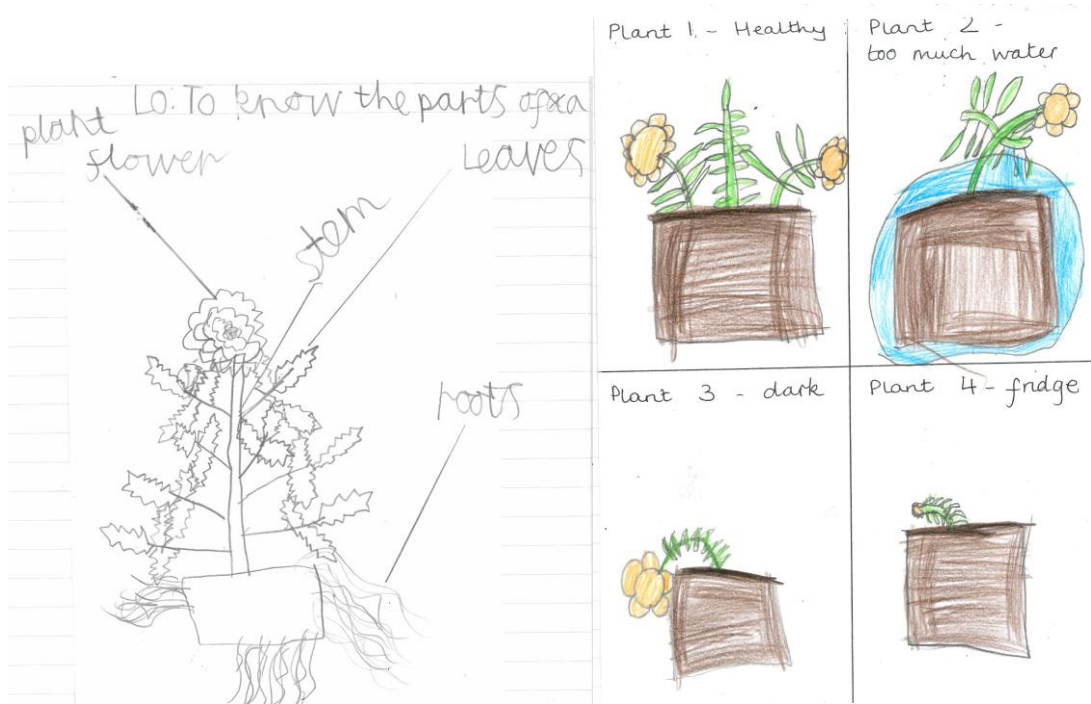
Pack life
