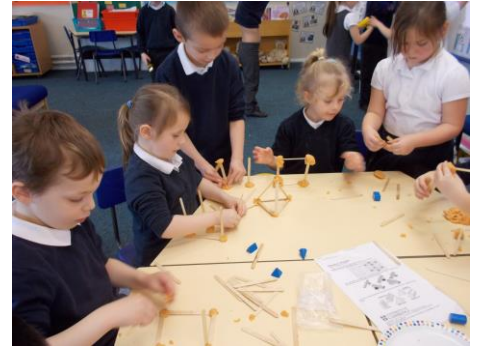


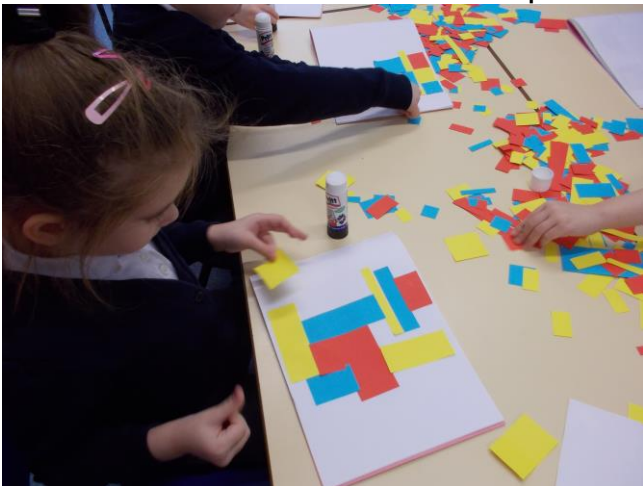
# What's in the box?

we have been investigating 3D shapes.

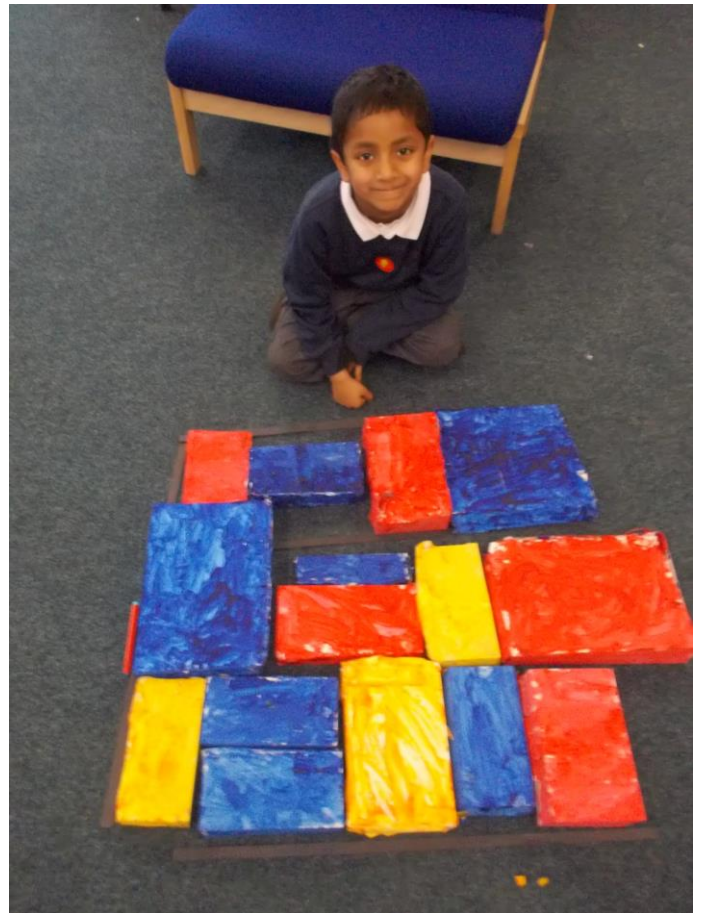


We looked at the work of the famous painter, Mondrian.

sculptures using our shapes.

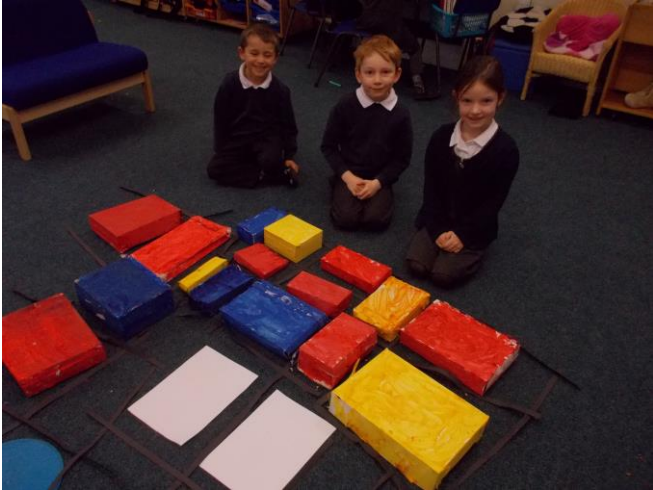


We then thought of how we feel when we receive a present,
