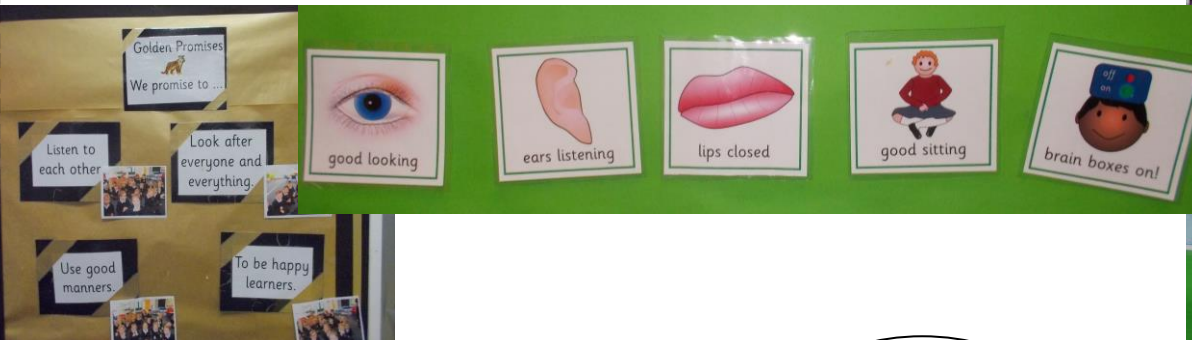


Tigers Autumn 1 2016 – ‘Next size up’
