Areas to develop:

- **Home learning** not aimed at the child – cant complete without adult help
- Some home learning takes 2/3 hours on top of reading, spelling and phonics
- More numeracy home learning needed
- Home learning needs to be less adult led
- Reading, spelling and home learning is too much every week
- Child tired after school and doesn't want to read much
- Would like more information on my **child's progress** (where I can help to improve)
- Not always keen to do home learning, but we get there in the end!
- First year of learning was excellent, but the next year not as stable as **change of teacher**
- Don't think **separating the classes** helped my child
- Apart from parents evenings, not informed on progress at school
- Home learning is a challenge if my child is tired and hard to do around out of school commitments
- Too much writing in year 2 home learning
- My child complains about home learning, and the quantity to do with reading and spelling is too much
- Don't find it easy to approach the class teacher (as a new parent)
- Home learning is challenging for child as exhausted and we work shifts
- With reading, spelling, phonics and home learning they don't have time to play
- Would welcome school packed lunches – more choice at **lunchtime** – teachers should lead by example at lunchtime
