This week

This week your child has;
In Phonics – learnt tricky word 'be' and new sounds 'j, v, w'.
In Mathematics you child has learnt 6, 7, 8 – and they have explored the different combinations to make these numbers.
Number formation rhymes;
6 – Down we go and make a loop, number 6 has a hoop.
7 – Across the sky and down from heaven that's the way to make a 7.
8 – Make a 'S' and do not wait. When it's joined up you have an 8.
In Understanding the World – gone on a stick hunt, learnt about stick safety and made stick creations.

Next week

Week 4 of home schooling;
Phonics – A new tricky word on Monday and 3 new sounds next week.
Mathematics – Adding numbers up to 8, finding the total using different strategies; objects, 10 frame, fingers and drawing pictures.
Expressive Arts and Design/ Literacy – Stick week continued...you will be making your own stories next week.
Funky Fingers – 3 activities for fine motor and two for gross motor. Remember to do a Funky Finger warm up either watch the videos on Tapestry or play some music and choose your warm up moves.
