Please choose 10 of the activities below:

<p>Help your grown-ups with the food shopping by helping to write the shopping list (using your sounds).</p>	<p>Set up your own ‘cardio circuit’ for your family- using some of the activities we do in PE!</p>	<p>Build a landmark that you have seen in Norwich. You can use anything- blocks, lego, junk modelling!</p>	<p>Draw a map of your walk to school – what do you see on your route?</p>
<p>Practice recognising your teen numbers (10-20). Can you find any around your home? Or outside?</p>	<p>Make a weather chart to record what the weather is like daily. Can you do this for two weeks, or a month? Do you spot any changes?</p>	<p>Go to https://www.ictgames.com/mobilePage/countingCaterpillar/index.html and try to order numbers 0-20.</p>	<p>Create a poster about yourself that includes a self-portrait and 3 important facts about you.</p>
<p>Choose one of your favourite books. Can you write a book review to persuade others to read it?</p>	<p>Play throw and catch with someone. Can you show the different passes you have learnt? Can you catch it using your spider hands?</p>	<p>Read a book with a grownup – have you found any new words? Can you use a dictionary (it can be online!) to find out what it means?</p>	<p>Look at the books you have at home and sort them into fiction and non-fiction. Which is your favourite fiction, and non-fiction? Why?</p>
<p>Draw a picture of your home and your family. Label your picture to tell us more- who do you live with? What is your home like?</p>	<p>Watch the video of Mrs Kelly on Tapestry and try to say all of the sounds on her flash cards! Practice reading and writing sounds you find more difficult to recognise.</p>	<p>Practice your letter formation for the letters in your name. Are all of your letters formed correctly? Practice makes perfect!</p>	<p>Go on a seasonal walk and look for signs of summer. Make sure you think about all 5 of your senses! What can you hear, smell, feel?</p>
<p>Practice forming the digits 0 – 9 correctly. Which are the most difficult? Practice in the air, mud, paint, or sand – wherever you want!</p>	<p>Go to https://www.ictgames.com/mobilePage/dinosaurEggs_phonics/index.html and try to read words containing sounds you have learnt.</p>	<p>Can you make your class animal using junk modelling? Think about the best way to join the pieces of junk together, how can you make it look more like a lion/panda?</p>	<p>Can you name the four countries in the UK? Choose one and research to find out more- you could use the library, books, and technology.</p>
